

MCA SPECIAL AWARDS

MCA recognizes that there are many show attendees who strive for a higher standard of excellence. For those owners with exceptional cars, they have an opportunity to “go to the next level”, by qualifying for some very special awards. There are several types of awards for different classes. In addition to the MCA Grille Medallion, there are special awards for Concours, Unrestored, Thoroughbred and Modified classes.

Note: All ties for all awards will be broken by the two Head Judges

PRESTIGE AWARD Division I & II - Concours

This special recognition is for those top Concours Trailered and Concours Driven Mustangs at the last National level show of the season **be it a Grand National or Regular National Show**. Any Concours Class in Division I & II is eligible to qualify for the Prestige Award.

- Highest Point *Score wins in each category (* Ties - Winner determined by Head Judges)
 - Concours Prestige Award I (Trailered, 1964 ½ - 1978)
 - Concours Prestige Award II (Trailered, 1979 - 1993)
 - Concours Prestige Award III (Trailered, 1994 - 2004)
 - Concours Prestige Award IV (Driven, 1964 ½ - 1978)
 - Concours Prestige Award V (Driven, 1979 - 1993)
 - Concours Prestige Award VI (Driven, 1994 - 2004)

Criteria for Winning:

Requirements for winning the Prestige Award in each of the established Concours Classes are as follows:

Show year accumulation of Show points for each of the Concours classes

1. Cumulative points for each of the six Concours Classes:

National Shows

*Gold = 2 Points

*Silver = 1 Point

Grand National or last show of the year

*Gold = 3 Points

*Silver = 2 Points

2. Concours Cars with the highest total of cumulative points at end of the show year and has received a Gold with the lowest amount of deductions at the final show, win a special Prestige award in each class.

3.* Advantages: Incentive for Concours Mustang show participants to enter as many shows as they can in order to accumulate credit points.

4. Each of the winning Concours Mustangs must be present at the show at which awards are given.

**PLATINUM AWARD
Division III A - Unrestored**

The Unrestored Mustang is considered to be of historical value and one that can be a reference for other Mustang enthusiasts desiring to restore their Mustang to Conco's original. To recognize Unrestored Mustang owners who have conserved their original Mustang to the highest degree possible, MCA will honor those individuals with a Platinum Award. This award will be given at the last National level show of the season ***be it a Grand National or Regular National Show.***

Requirements for winning the Platinum Award in each of the established Unrestored "A" Classes are as follows:

Requirements for the Unrestored Platinum award below must be satisfied:

1. **Gold Award** (Including Bonus Points which will be factored in)
641/2- 2004: Must score 99% of *total* points (-7)

Criteria for winning

Unrestored "A" Cars with the highest total of cumulative points at end of the show year, and has received a Gold with the lowest amount of deductions at the final show, win a special Platinum Award in each class.

Show year accumulation of show points for each of the Unrestored classes

2. Cumulative points for each of the Unrestored "A" Classes:

<i>National Shows</i>	<i>Grand National or last show of the year</i>
*Gold = 2 Points	*Gold = 3 Points
*Silver = 1 Point	*Silver = 2 Points
3. *Advantages: Incentive for Unrestored "A" Mustang show participants to enter as many shows as they can in order to accumulate credit points.
4. ***Each of the winning Unrestored "A" Mustangs must be present at the show at which awards are given.***

PRESERVATION AWARD

Division III B - Preservation

The preserved Mustang is considered to have future historical value and one that can be a reference for other Mustang enthusiasts desiring to restore their Mustang to Concours original. To recognize preserved Mustang owners who have preserved their original Mustang to the highest degree possible, MCA will honor those individuals with a Preservation Award. This award will be given at the last National level show of the season ***be it a Grand National or Regular National Show.***

Requirements for winning the Preservation Award in the established Preservation "B" Classes are as follows:

1. Gold Award

2005-2013: Must score (99% of **total** points -7)

Preservation Cars with the highest total of cumulative points at end of the show year, and has received a Gold with the lowest amount of deductions at the final show, win a special Preservation Award.

2. Cumulative points in the Preservation class:

National Shows

*Gold = 2 Points

*Silver = 1 Point

Grand National or last show of the year

*Gold = 3 Points

*Silver = 2 Points

3. *Advantages: Incentive for Preservation Mustang show participants to enter as many shows as they can in order to accumulate points.

4. *Winning Mustangs must be present at the show at which awards are given.*

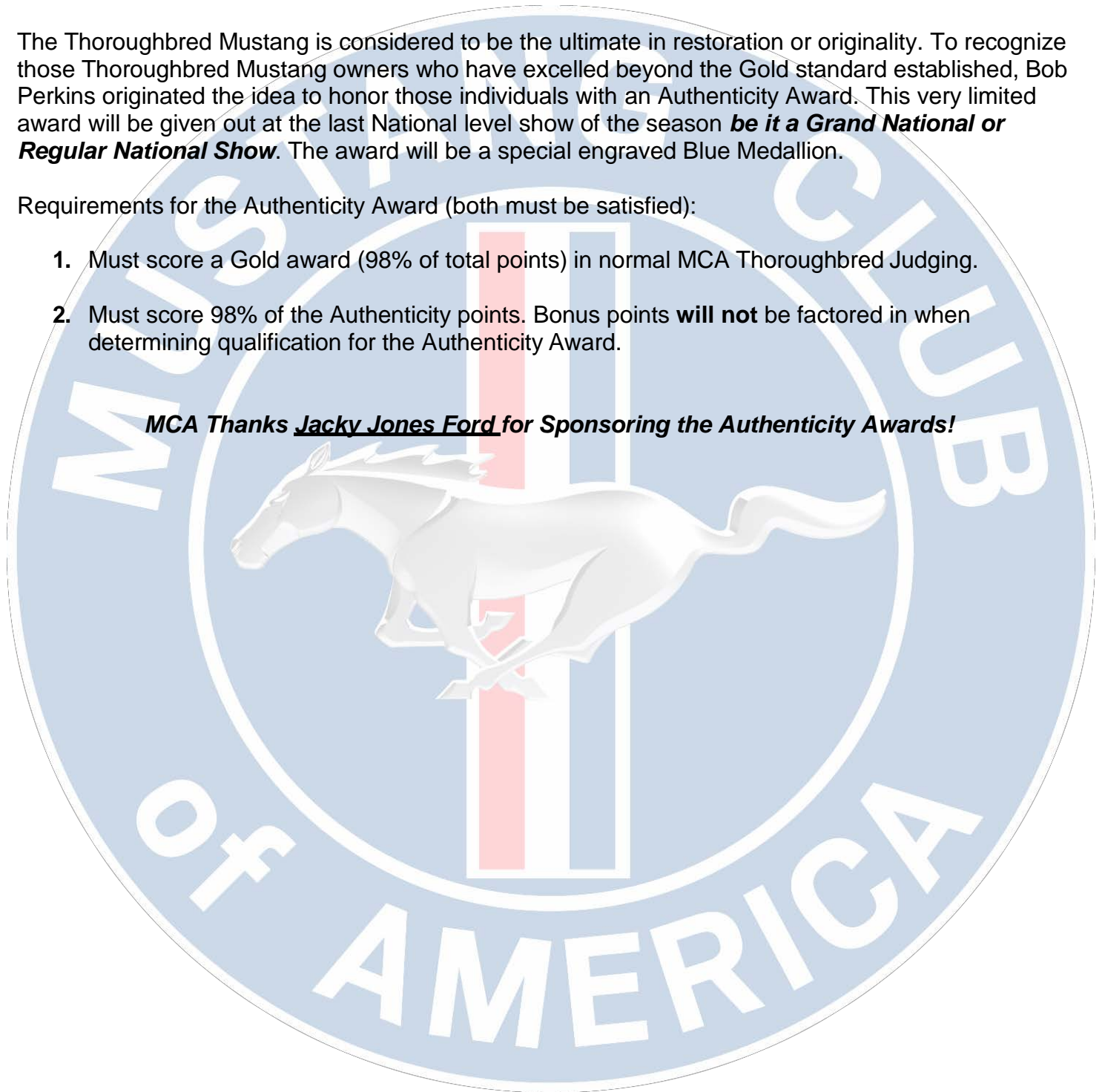
AUTHENTICITY AWARD
Division IV - Thoroughbred

The Thoroughbred Mustang is considered to be the ultimate in restoration or originality. To recognize those Thoroughbred Mustang owners who have excelled beyond the Gold standard established, Bob Perkins originated the idea to honor those individuals with an Authenticity Award. This very limited award will be given out at the last National level show of the season ***be it a Grand National or Regular National Show***. The award will be a special engraved Blue Medallion.

Requirements for the Authenticity Award (both must be satisfied):

1. Must score a Gold award (98% of total points) in normal MCA Thoroughbred Judging.
2. Must score 98% of the Authenticity points. Bonus points **will not** be factored in when determining qualification for the Authenticity Award.

PINNACLE AWARD
Division VII - Modified

The Modified Mustang car is considered to be an expression of an individual's extension of himself or herself in terms of original concept, design, and quality building of a very special automobile. These cars represent free thinking with no limitations on far out design that tests the limits of imagination and the challenges of creating a functional and beautiful Mustang.

This recognition will be given at the last National level show of the season ***be it a Grand National or Regular National Show.***

Requirements for winning the Pinnacle Award in each of the established Modified Classes excluding Modified Extreme are as follows:

Special Bonus Show Credit points for each of the Modified Classes:

National Shows

*Gold = 2 Points

*Silver = 1 Point

Grand National or last show of the year

*Gold = 3 Points

*Silver = 2 Points

All modified cars with the highest sum total of cumulative bonus points at the end of the year **and** receive a Gold Award at the final show of the year, shall be considered for the Pinnacle Award. In the event of a tying score of cumulative points, the sum of the individual judging sheet scores for that show year shall be totaled to determine the Pinnacle award winner.

*Advantages: Incentive for Modified Mustang show participants to enter as many shows as they can in order to accumulate points.

Each of the winning Modified Mustangs must be present at the show at which awards are given.

Feral Horse Award

Feral Horse often is popularly called "wild" horses. Feral horses are descended from domestic horses. The Feral horse is considered to be the ultimate in wild Ponies. To recognize the Modified Extreme Class Mustang owners who have excelled beyond the established Gold Modified Extreme Standard, this very limited award would be given out at the last National level show of the season, be it a Grand National or National Show. The Feral Hoarse Award will be presented to the Modified Extreme Class pony cars that meet the standards. Requirements for the Feral Horse award (all must be satisfied) are as follows:

1. Must Score 98.5% or better on total Cleanliness, Workmanship and condition Points.
2. Must score 98.5% in the Modified points.
3. Must attend and score a gold in at least one other national show in the show season and score a gold in the last national show whether it be a national or grand national in the same show season.
