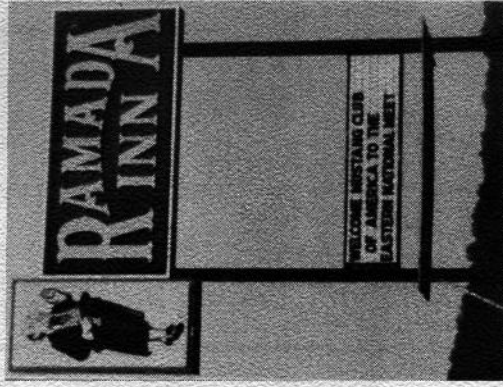

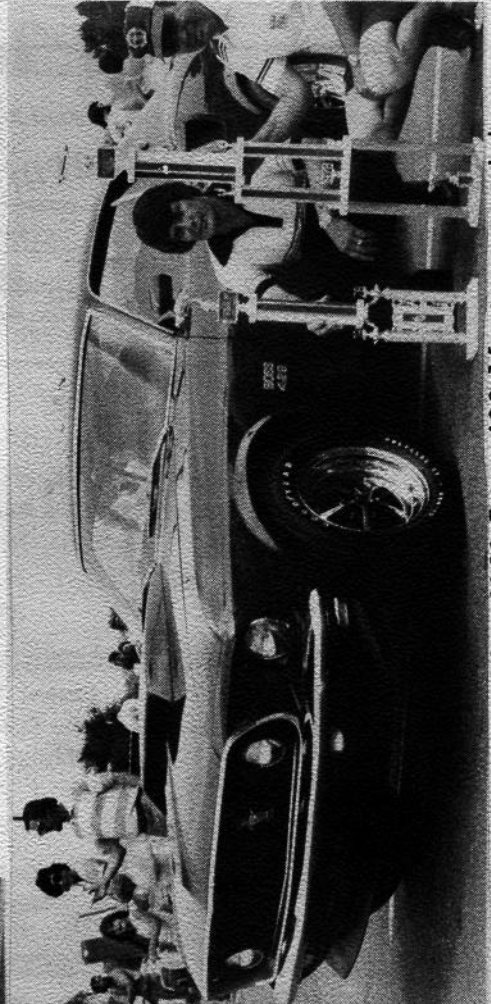
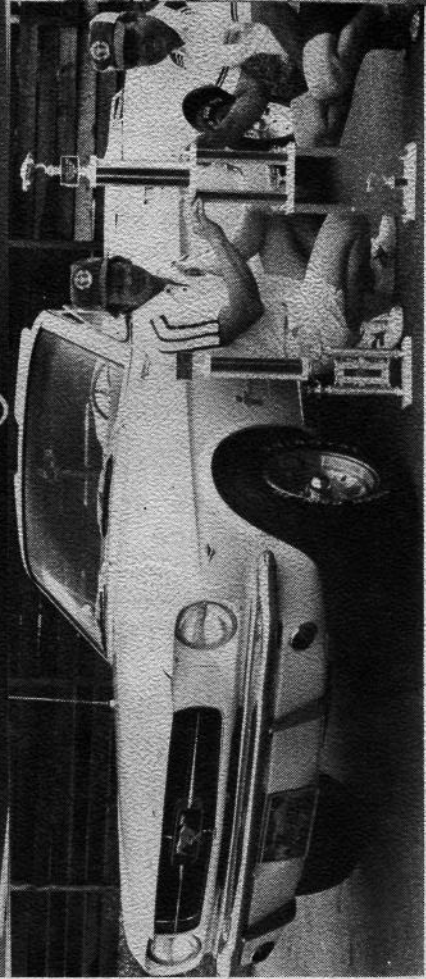


Ralph Smith and his 1965 Mustang convertible (Modified) receiving Best of Show, Junior Division Driven trophy from Don Wolfe.

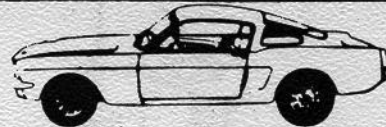

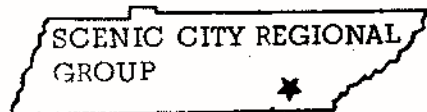


MUSTANG OWNERS' CLUB OF SOUTHEASTERN MICHIGAN
