

BOARD OF DIRECTORS *NOMINATIONS*

WANTED: People who have the love for the MCA and the energy and dedication to help make the MCA the most premier car club in the world. This is the time of the year when the Nominating Committee accepts submissions for positions on the National Board of Directors and for the Officers of the Mustang Club of America. We are represented all around the world by different Mustang clubs and that number is still growing. We cannot achieve this task without your help.

We are seeking hard-working, dedicated men and women who want to become part of this great team by running for a position on the Board. You might ask, "Why me?" And we'll ask you, "Why not?" Don't be afraid to jump in to get your feet wet. It is so worthwhile.

At the end of December 2026, several Directors' terms will expire. It's time to submit your name and a short Bio for nomination for one of these positions. You must be a current MCA member in good standing and 18 years of age before October 1, 2026, to serve on the Board of Directors. To serve as an officer, you must have at least two years of experience as a Regional or National Director.

Please remember that serving on the Board in any capacity is not a name-only position. You will be required to put forth a lot of effort, time, and personal expense to attend Board of Directors meetings. Bylaws state that the Board is required to meet four to six times a year. Each year the BOD members vote on meeting locations.

Board members usually sit on at least one committee and will be required to attend meetings of those committees. Some meetings are held before the BOD meetings and some by way of conference calls. As with any organization, there are many items to discuss and evaluate. Items passed in committee meetings will be presented to the Board for a vote. The Board operates as a business and is accountable to its members.

Some other responsibilities are talking to regional club representatives and their members by phone. You will also represent the MCA at any National, Grand National, and Regional events you attend. You will represent the feelings and rulings of the Board members as well as nonmembers at the events you attend. Remember, you're an extension of the MCA and will need to conduct yourself as such.

You will not be compensated monetarily. Your satisfaction will be knowing that you played a part in running the largest Mustang car club in the world. Please give this opportunity serious consideration before making this important decision. The goal of the MCA is to have representation from all areas of the country. To make your intentions known, you must submit a biography of no more than 300 words to the Nominating Committee before June 10, 2026. Bios longer than 300 words will be edited for space. In addition, you must include

your name, MCA number, full address, local club affiliation, and office held within the MCA or Regional Club. A good, recent high-resolution photo of yourself must be submitted as part of your bio.

Your picture and bio will run in the August issue of *Mustang Times*. Elections will take place in the month of September. One ballot per eligible MCA number is sent via email; active MCA members over the age of 18 are allowed to vote for the Board of Directors. The positions on the Executive Committee are elected by votes from the Regional and National Directors.

The deadline for submitting your biography and photo is June 10, 2026. If you do not receive confirmation from the Nominating Committee within 48 hours, please contact one of the committee members below.
